"...BE SURE YOUR SIN WILL FIND YOU OUT"
(NUMBERS 32:23)

There is an "old preacher story" that goes something like this: A preacher inadvertently overheard one of the members swearing profusely. He did not make himself known to the man, but decided to preach on the subject in the hope the man would recognize himself and repent, along with any others who might have been guilty at some time, or other.

After his sermon, to his surprise a very refined, but red faced lady approached him and indignantly exclaimed: "You should be ashamed; sneaking around like that. If I had known you were listening, I would never have said those things." A man came to him and said, "You have probably said the same things I did, when you thought no one was around". Whereas, the real culprit, slapped him on the shoulder and said, "You tell 'em preacher; that will show them they should be more careful".

The scripture that heads this article has to do with the children of Gad and the children of Reuben promising Moses they would help the other tribes to conquer Canaan, if they would be permitted to settle east of Jordan. Moses said, if you do not help them, you have sinned against the Lord, and He will know it.

Surely, all Christians who know anything about the omniscience of the Lord know that He sees and knows all. Psa. 33:13-15: He looks from heaven on all the inhabitants of the earth. Prov. 15:3: He watches the good and evil in every place. Dan. 2:22: He reveals deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, and light dwells with Him. Job 34:21: His eyes are on the ways of men, and He sees all their steps. Rom. 13:12: Paul wrote: "The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light." 1 Cor. 4:5: He also wrote: that when, the Lord comes, He will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts.

If anyone, especially, any Christian is prone to think they can engage in what they think is private sin and not have to account for it, it is a grave self-deception. The fact is; most times it is widely known by others, but even if it is not, the Lord knows and weeps.

Tragically, it is often true that parents surreptitiously condone, overlook, encourage, or even participate with or in the sin of their children, and think they are doing so with impunity.

If and when sin is pointed out in an effort to help save a soul from death, sometimes the helper faces indignation and wrath. One must wonder; if the sinner, especially, the ones who have always considered themselves to be safe, will be indignant at the Lord in the final judgment.

Hypocrisy is, also, surely, one of the most despicable of sins. If we examine ourselves and find that we are guilty, please let us return to the Lord; repent, confess our sins, pray for forgiveness and be a productive Christian in the Body of Christ henceforth.
